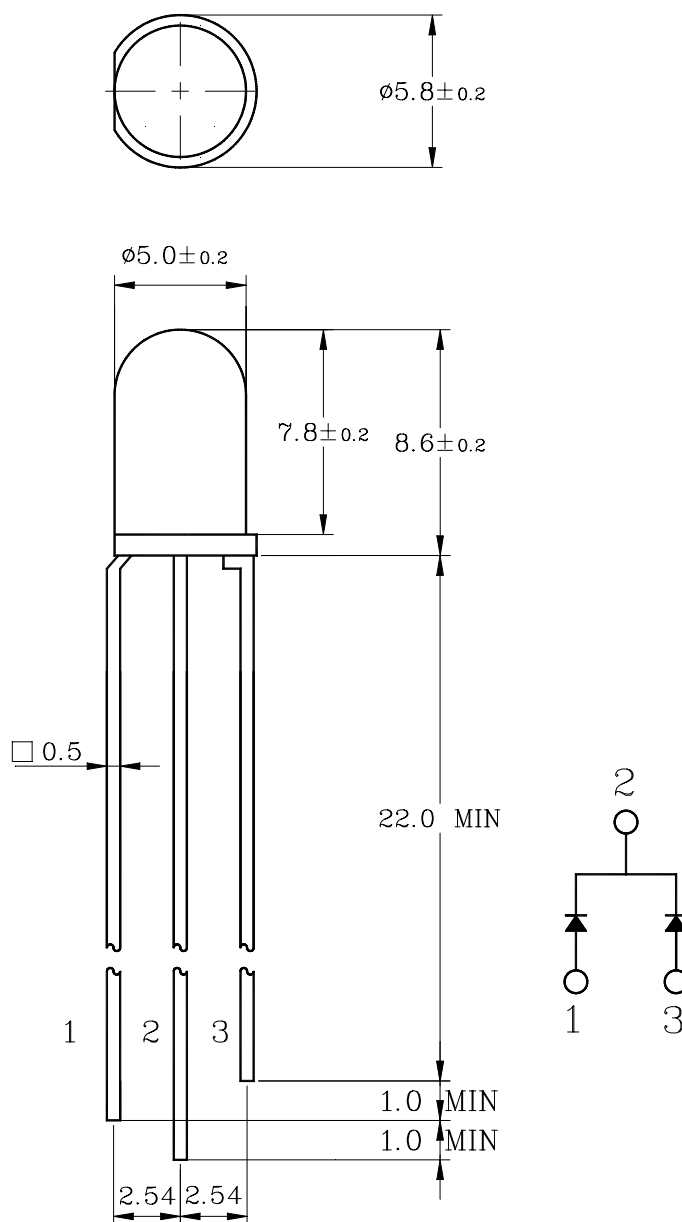

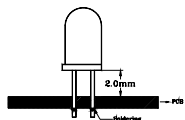

Fig. 1 $I_F - V_F$

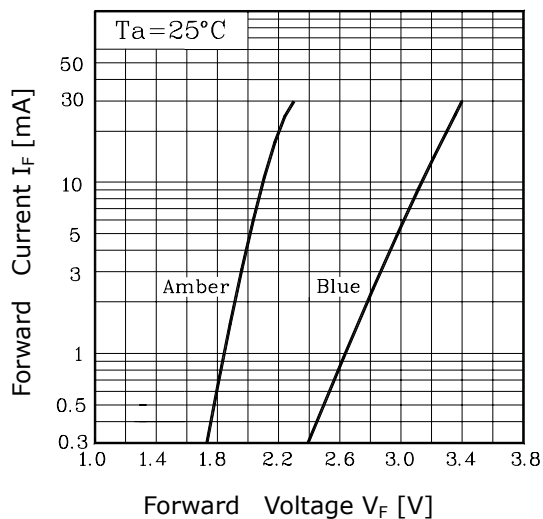


Fig. 2 $I_V - I_F$

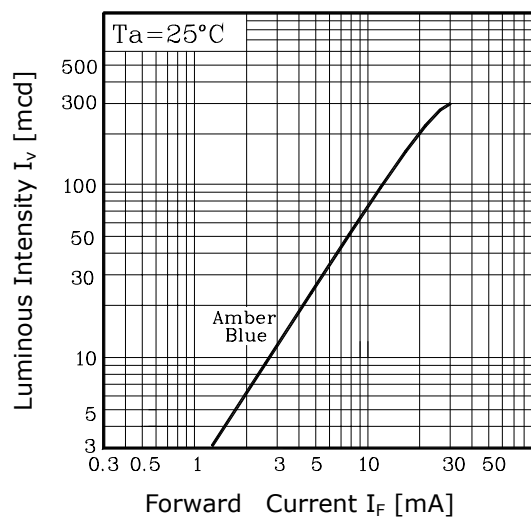


Fig. 3 $I_F - T_a$

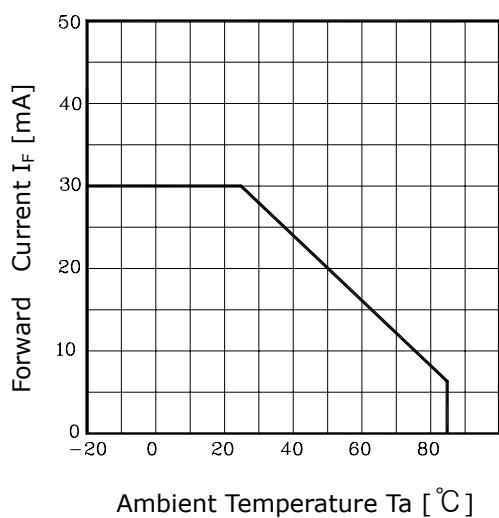


Fig.4 Spectrum Distribution

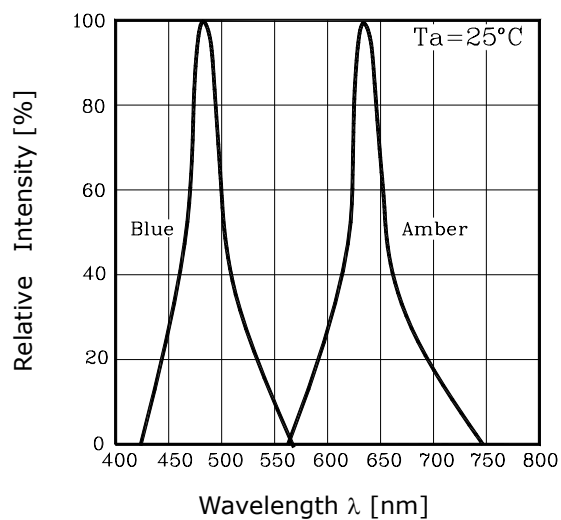
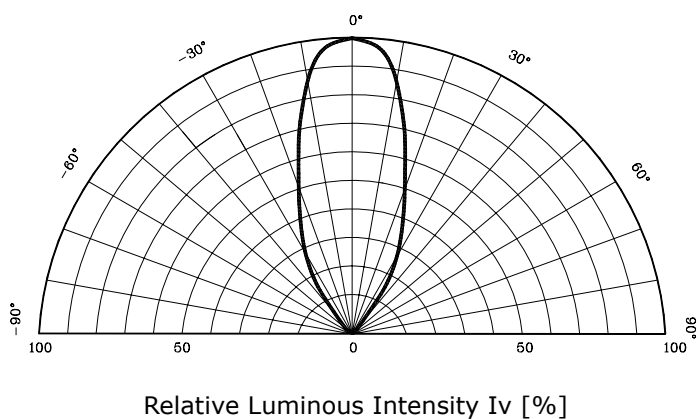


Fig. 5 Radiation Diagram



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
